Scams to watch out for

Whether it be via text message, a phone call, email or via social media, scam artists will stop at nothing to try and gain access to your money and personal information.



Be on the lookout

The most important thing to know is that scams exist and be on the lookout for them.

- Always make sure you know who you are dealing with or talking to. If something seems too good to be true, it probably is.
- If you are not sure that an offer is genuine, do not go through with the purchase or share personal details.
- Check if the company is registered through the <u>ABN lookup website</u> (https://abr.business.gov.au/)
- Read reviews of the business and check for signs that it could be a scam.
- Use a credit card rather than a debit card or bank transfer so that you can ask your bank for a charge back.
- Keep up to date at *Scamwatch:* The ACCC's <u>Scamwatch website</u> (https://www.scamwatch.gov.au/) has up-to-date information about scams and how to get help if you have been impacted by a scam.


