#### From the CEO of Volunteering Australia

In response to the latest budget, the CEO of Volunteer Australia, Mark Pearce, has commended the Treasure's commitment to 'measuring what matters'.

"We support the aspiration for a Budget process that better reflects what people value." Pearce said. "Australians value volunteering and the wellbeing benefits it brings to individuals, communities, and the nation ... it is essential that volunteering is included in the frameworks and metrics that are used to track wellbeing and to guide the allocation of spending."

The Treasure also highlighted the crucial role of



volunteers in crisis resilience, pledging \$38.3 million to Disaster Relief Australia for the National Veteran Volunteer Service.

Mark Pearce said, "The additional funding ... will lead to a total of around 6,700 veterans to provide over 13,600 volunteer days per annum. Through volunteering, this initiative will help provide wellbeing and sense of purpose for ADF veterans."
